IDEH is pleased to announce the initial offering of *125<sup>th</sup>: Time in Harlem*, a limited edition artist's book resulting from a unique collaboration between two photographers. Over a span of four years Edward Hillel and Isaac Diggs together photographed the length and breadth of Harlem's main thoroughfare 125<sup>th</sup> Street with a large format camera. Named one of America's great streets by the American Planning Association, New York's historic cross-road of Black culture is now, like so many similar neighborhoods in other US cities, undergoing gentrification. The sumptuous color plates are a meditation on time and memory, evoking the shifting realities of a contested landscape as history meets the contemporary moment.

### **This first edition of *125<sup>th</sup>: Time in Harlem* is limited to 500 including:**

Editions 1 through 125 are a Collectors' Edition in a clothbound hard-shell stamped slipcase. Each book is stamped, numbered and signed, and includes a signed and numbered 8x10 inch archival pigment print.

The book features 68 color plates in a linen-clad hardcover with deboss, typeset in Helvetica Neue Light and offset printed on Galerie Art Silk 176/gsm paper.

Book design by Patricia Childers, contributions from historian Jonathan Gill, with an insightful essay by noted photography critic Vicki Goldberg.
